Registration Instructions

- 1) Register online at www.camphighroad.org.
- 2) Pay a \$100 deposit per child, per week, either online with a credit card or by check by printing the registration form and mailing it in with a check.
- 3) Once we have received your registration information, we will e-mail you a copy of the health forms, packing list, and any other pertinent information.
- 4) Full payment is due two weeks before your camper's session, and will automatically be charged to your credit card unless you have sent a check or made special arrangements.

Additional Registration Information

- Any payments, including the deposit, made to Highroad are refundable (minus a \$25 processing fee) if a cancellation is received in writing/e-mail 30 days prior to the applicable session.
- Refunds are given for medical emergencies regardless of the amount of notice.
- Age groups are based on the grade that your camper will enter in the fall of 2012.

Camp Highroad

Camp Highroad Christian Adventure Camp is a non-profit camp dedicated to sharing the gospel by providing a "place apart" for our guests. Our aim is to give every child at summer camp a quality experience of fellowship, fun, adventure and growth in faith. Camp Highroad is located in beautiful Middleburg, Virginia at the foot of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Highroad is just one hour from Washington, D.C. and thirty minutes from Leesburg, VA. Camp Highroad is open to all children regardless of their age, race, religion, disabilities, gender, family status, or nationality. We are a Christian camp, and behavior and clothing consistent with Christian values are expected! Highroad is accredited by the American Camping Association and maintains a consistent record of safety, quality programming, and "happy campers!"

Summer Theme: Out Of This World

The Bible tells us in John 15:19 that "you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world." While that sounds kind of cool, and a little bit scary, it can be hard for us understand what it really means. This summer, campers will have an opportunity to learn about God and what it truly means to be his special creation, set aside from this world. Each day, campers will learn how the Bible points us to Jesus Christ and how His love, kindness, passion and missions are "Out Of This World"





Elementary Camps

Each Elementary camper will be a part of a small group made up of two counselors and a maximum of fourteen campers. The small group will do all their camp activities together for 5 ½ days and share two rustic cabins for five nights. They will enjoy great meals and a range of fun activities. See the Activity List to learn what activities are available for this age group!

Adventurers Camp is for rising 3rd and 4th graders. For many Adventurers this will be their first week away from home! (\$385.00 per session).

Explorers Camp is for rising 5th and 6th graders. (\$385.00 per session).

Junior High Camps

Junior High campers will be a part of a small group made up of two counselors and a maximum of sixteen campers. The small group will do all their camp activities together for 5 ½ days and five nights. They will enjoy specialized camp activities, depending on the camp. See the Activity List to learn what activities are available for this age group. Junior High campers can register for Trailblazers, Jr. Wranglers, Mountain Boarding and Choral camps.

Trailblazers Camp is for rising 7th and 8th graders.

These campers will participate in a wide range of camp activities. They will spend their nights and free time in the air-conditioned Pine Lodge. (\$390.00 per session).

IMPROVED! Junior High Wranglers Camp

is for rising 7th and 8th graders who are interested in learning more about horses and riding. **Starting this year, Wranglers will stay in the beautiful, air-conditioned Willow Lodge!** Campers will be assigned their own horse for the week and they will feed and care for it. Wrangler campers will learn how to tack their horse, and how to ride safely and confidently! (\$500.00 per session).





High School Camps

High School campers will be a part of a small group made up of two counselors and a maximum of twenty campers. The small group will do all their camp activities together for 5 ½ days and five nights. They will enjoy great meals and can do many of the activities that are offered at camp. See the Activity List to learn what activities are available for this age group. High School campers can register for Voyagers, Sr. Wranglers, Mountain Boarding, Choral and High Adventure camps.

Voyagers Camp is for rising 9th through 12th graders who will spend their nights and free time in air-conditioned Oak Lodge. This is the largest lodge at Camp Highroad and provides the best space for conversation and community. In addition to having so many activities available, Voyagers have a more flexible sleeping schedule. Breakfast is delivered, and activities start and finish later than for younger campers. (\$410.00 per session).

IMPROVED! High School Wranglers Camp is for rising 9th through 12th graders who are interested in learning more about horses or expanding upon what they have learned in Junior High Wranglers Camp. **Starting this year, Wranglers will stay in beautiful, air-conditioned Willow Lodge!** Campers will care for and feed the horses as well as learn how to properly tack and ride throughout the week. High School Wranglers will also get to ride on more advanced trails, as well as taking part in night activities, such as hikes, pool times and zip. (\$500.00 per session).

NEW! High Adventure Camp is for rising 9th through 12th graders who will spend their nights and free time in air-conditioned Oak Lodge. High Adventurers will spend two days off-camp whitewater rafting, caving, and hiking! During their three days on camp, they will do our most exciting activities and share in the great night programs that we run for Voyagers! (\$500.00 per person)





Specialty Camps

NEW! Graduated Seniors Mission Camp

This year, Mission Camp is an opportunity for recent high school graduates to return to community at Highroad and to use their time and talents to make a difference in the larger community outside of camp. These young adults will put the faith that they have grown over their years at Highroad into practice by travelling to a mission site and running a "Camp Style" Vacation Bible School, for children who wouldn't otherwise get to experience the fun and discipleship of camp. The grads will stay in the cabins every night and will travel with a team of Highroad counselors to their mission project each morning. During their time on camp, the grads will use our high-ropes course, lead devotions for their group and, with the help of our counselors, will prepare for challenges that they will face when they enter college or careers! (\$360.00 per session).

Choral Camp is for rising 7th through 12th graders who love to sing. Staying in the air-conditioned Oak Lodge, campers will rehearse daily in preparation for special presentations on camp during the week, and at two churches the Sunday following camp. These Campers will also have the opportunity to enjoy many of Highroad's most popular activities. (\$410.00 per session).

Mountain Board Camp is for rising 7th through 12th graders. They will stay in rustic cabins and spend each morning mountain boarding and each afternoon doing other exciting camp activities. Boards and safety equipment will be provided. This camp is for all levels of skill. (\$410.00 per session).
